OUR MISSION is to help people with disabilities and seniors attain independence and dignity by creating opportunities for participation in the community.

Skill Building

Skill Building is a model of community-based activities that teach concepts such as attendance, task completion, and problemsolving. Goals are based on the identified needs and desires of the person served.

Individuals have the opportunity to participate in volunteer work, career exploration and business tours, learning soft skills related to employment. Activities include computer training, mobility training, healthy eating, exercise and job readiness skills.



Community Living Supports

Group Community Living Supports, or Group CLS, is a place to learn, grow, empower, and make new friends; a place to take advantage of what the community has to offer.



Staff work with participants to increase independence and comfort in their own community, working toward goals such as community exploration, educational opportunities, health and wellness activities, and socialization with others.



Supported Employment

Individuals who have successfully surpassed 90 days of employment are eligible to receive long-term support. The purpose of this program is to assist individuals in becoming as successful as possible in their employment. Job development staff check-in regularly with individuals as well as the employer, addressing any concerns that arise and provide additional support as needed.
